“Incredible changes and exciting horizons: The Brighton Stroke Unit 12 years on”



Dr Philip Thompson was appointed as Stroke Consultant at Brighton & Sussex Universities NHS Trust in August 2015. He qualified at Cardiff Medical School in 2001 and spent 8 years of his junior doctor training in Brighton. He commenced training in Elderly Medicine before undertaking stroke specialist training at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust.

He was awarded a PhD at Brighton & Sussex Medical School for a thesis entitled 'Blood pressure, the brain, and quality of life, in elderly people with chronic kidney disease' in April 2013. He ran the 1st Brighton Marathon to raise money for the Friends of Brighton & Hove Hospitals and works as an advisor to a medical assistance and overseas repatriation company.
