“From Paddington to Gaza”

He trained at St Thomas' Hospital, London, and the Brigham Hospital, Harvard, following which he was appointed to St Mary's Hospital medical School in London and Hammersmith Post-Graduate Medical School. He developed a successful tertiary referral centre for complex aneurysms and trained large number of senior fellows who became successful vascular surgeons in the NHS and abroad.

He was a Hunterian Professor of the Royal College of Surgeons and a Moynihan Fellow of the Association of Surgeons of Great Britain and Ireland. He has published over 300 peer reviewed articles and over 100 book chapters. He was the President of the European Board of Surgery (2004-2005), President of the Vascular Society of Great Britain and Ireland (2005-2006), President of the European Society for Vascular Surgery (2008-2009) and President of the World Federation of Vascular Societies (20012-2013).

He represented vascular Surgery in the Royal College of Surgeons of England, the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, the European Union (UEMS) and the Association of Surgeons. He is an Honorary Member of the Society of Vascular Surgeons (USA), Vascular Society of India, Vascular Society of South Africa, Society of Vascular Surgery and Australia and New Zealand, Swiss Vascular Society, German Vascular Society, Society of European Surgeons in Training, British Society of Vascular Technologists and the Association of Surgeons of India.

He has been closely involved with the development of vascular training, vascular workshops and has recently been training and advising the MOH in Gaza on arterial services.
