**“Removing vulnerabilities: the ethical case for clinical research involving children and young people”**



Bobbie Farsides is Professor of Clinical and Biomedical Ethics at BSMS. She has a long standing interest in the role of ethicists within the health and public policy arena and has served on a number of committees and taskforces. She has also broadcast on ethical issues. She has served as a specialist adviser to the House of Lords on issues related to assisted dying and organ donation.

Her talk will take the audience through the journey that she and the Nuffield Council working party travelled to produce their newly published report - a journey that was just as much about eating pizza, playing games involving chocolate and working with film crews as it was about hearing from experts in the field of paediatric medicine and research.
