“HIV 1981-2015”



Yvonne Gilleece is a Consultant and Honorary Senior Lecturer in HIV/GUM and Joint Principal Lead Consultant at Brighton & Sussex University Hospitals NHS Trust and is also the Chair of Sussex HIV Network. She is the Lead for HIV in Pregnancy, Conception and Reproductive Health, Hepatitis and Liver Dysfunction as well as being clinical supervisor for a PhD on HIV and Bone. She is Vice Chair for the BHIVA guidelines on HIV in Pregnancy and an author of the Adult Treatment Guidelines and HIV-2. She is a member of the BHIVA Audit Committee, BASHH HIV SIG and teaches for the Diplomas in GUM and HIV and the BHIVA HIV Inpatient Course

Daniel Richardson is consultant Physician and senior lecturer in sexual health and HIV medicine at Brighton & Sussex University Hospitals NHS Trust. His special interest is in the healthcare of men who have sex with men. He runs the local MSM clinic and anal dysplasia clinics as well as contributing to the general STI and HIV services. He is the national BASHH (British Association for Sexual Health and HIV) conference organiser chairing the BASHH scientific committees and conference committees including the joint FRSB-BASHH conference and joint RCP-BASHH conferences. He supervises a PhD investigating the feasibility and acceptability of HPV vaccine in men who have sex with men.
